



# Turning Point Schools Reopening Plan 2020-2021

Thank you for choosing TP Schools for the 2020-2021 school year! We are excited to start this new year with the safety of your child as our top priority. Please take time to read the following health and safety protocols that will be implemented at the start of the year. School will begin in person on **Monday August 17, 2020 at 7:50 a.m.**

## Health and Safety Protocol

### Enhanced Cleaning Protocol

- Increased number of hand sanitation stations throughout the school building.
- Safe, effective, cleaning products used for intense cleaning daily.

### COVID Positive Protocol

- Individuals who have tested positive for the COVID-19 or experiencing COVID like symptoms must be quarantined for 14 days before returning to school.

### Other Illness Policy

If a staff member or student has a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher, they must be fever-free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and be symptom free for 10 days before returning to school.

#### Masks



Students and staff are required to have a mask with them at all times. During various school settings wearing a mask will be required by both staff and students.

#### Restricted Visitors and Guests



Visitors and guests will be restricted from entering our building. No outside deliveries for staff or students.

#### Training



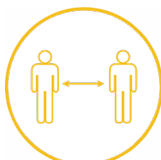
All staff are required to go through symptoms and screening measures training prior to the start of the school year.

#### Stay Home If Sick



Your child is required to stay home if ill. Sick students will need to be picked up within 30 -45 minutes of parent contact.

#### Social Distancing



We will maximize social distancing within instructional space.

#### School Clinic



School clinic will identify a separate space to treat symptomatic students.

#### Hand Washing



Additional hand-washing breaks will be taken throughout the day. As well as hand sanitizer stations in all classrooms.

#### Water Bottles



All students will be allowed to carry water bottles. Water fountains will only be permitted for the use of filling water bottles.

#### No Outside Items



Students will not be allowed to bring home items in the school, this includes bookbags.

# School and Classroom Changes

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## Drop-Off Procedures

- All staff and students must enter the building with their PPE mask on.
- Temperatures checks will be taken daily as staff and students enter the building.
- All students will enter the building at the front doors.
- Parents will need to scan students in and must check in with the front office each time.
- Non-staff members will not be permitted to go beyond the front office.

## Pick-Up Procedures

**PreK - 1st grade and all aftercare students will be pick up on the south side of the school building (near flagpoles).**

- Between 4:00 p.m.- 4:30 p.m. parents will drive up, check students out, and wait for students to come outside to vehicles.
- Aftercare parents will come inside, check-in with the front office, and wait in the entry for students.
- Non-staff members and parents are not permitted inside building beyond front office.

**2nd grade - 8th grade will pick up on the West side of the building (gym)**

- Parents will stay in vehicles and students will be called out.
- Pick-up for all students not in aftercare is between 4:00p.m.-4:30p.m.
- Aftercare pick-up is between 4:30p.m.-6:00p.m.; parents will check in with the front office and wait in entry way for students.

## Cafeteria Adjustments

- Alternative scheduling to adhere to safety guidelines.
- No visitors for lunch.
- Adjustments to seating to maximize social distancing.
- Additional cleaning protocol between lunches.

## Recess

- Open playgrounds with separate stations for sanitation.
- Additional and enhanced cleaning schedule for playgrounds.
